PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

With advances in technology, scanning and milling, and digital impression and designs, the possibilities for restorative options are expanding. This lecture will offer an organized framework for understanding and selecting materials and when to use conventional or CAD/CAM technology. Participants will discuss materials and differences between titanium and zirconia abutments, milling vs. casting techniques, PFM vs. all-ceramic, and digital vs. conventional techniques. New options for layering porcelain or composite onto cobalt-chromium metal frameworks will be discussed, including case selection, crown materials, CAD/CAM and digital workflows.

SPEAKER



Dr. Matthew Palermo is originally from Toronto, Canada, where he completed an Honors Bachelor of Science degree in 2001 at the University of Toronto. He received his DMD and AEGD from Temple University Kornberg School of Dentistry ('05 and '06), and received his specialty certificate in prosthodontics from the University of Rochester in 2009 (where he maintains an adjunct faculty position in the Division of Prosthodontics).

Dr. Palermo has maintained a full-time faculty appointment at Temple University Kornberg School of Dentistry since 2009. He is the Acting Chairperson of the Department of Restorative Dentistry and is the predoctoral implantology discipline coordinator. Other course and program directorships at Temple include: Basic and Advanced Interdisciplinary Implantology, Junior and Senior Clinical Restorative Dentistry, and Post-doctoral Grand rounds.

He has delivered over 200 oral presentations, including lectures at national meetings for the American Academy of Periodontology ('12) and the American College of Prosthodontists ('11,'12,'13). Dr. Palermo currently serves as the Chair of the Predoctoral Educators section for the American College of Prosthodontists, and serves on the Executive Counsel for the American Prosthodontic Society.

Research interests include dental materials testing to decrease prosthetic implant complications. Dr. Palermo is a Fellow of the International Team for Implantology (ITI), is the lead author of the text-book series "Fundamentals of Contemporary Prosthodontics" (Wiley-Blackwell Publications), and maintains a part-time private practice limited to prosthodontics and implantology in Scranton, PA.
